Talked about potential fundraising that could be done to help pay for permanent signage for the Farmers Market and Rural Revival.

3. Education

- August 27th at 7:30 in the Community Center is a proposed date/time/place for a presentation by Mitch Mehlhaf, Dan Mehlhaf and Ben Brockmueller. The presentation would focus on soil erosion.
- Brent shared about the prairie hay on his farm and that it is still available as an educational activity (Lyle Preheim & Beth Kaufman both expressed interest last year in looking at the root system). Brent also said that if possible, he would like to do a prairie fire on it to help with weeds (which could also be an educational activity) this fall.

Other:

- Brent shared the estimates from Printed Impressions and Freeman Lumber for some permanent signage in town. At this point, the cost would be just under \$2300 and no location has been found. A grant request could be submitted to the Freeman Community Foundation to assist with the cost.
- Tim asked if some more "smaller" educational events could happen over the next few months. Climate change is a topic that he would be interested in hearing/learning about.
